Dall Energy signs the largest deal in the company's history

Danish biomass energy company, Dall Energy, has landed what it describes as the largest ever contract for the company.

Dall Energy, together with French energy company Coriance / Caen la Mer Energie Verte, will contribute to a large-scale project to supply green energy to 40,000 French homes.

Dall Energy will be involved in a project centered around the Caen Nord and Hérouville-Saint-Clair district heating network in Caen la Mer.

"We are proud to work with Coriance again and to be part of this huge project that will fundamentally change the district heating network in Caen la Mer," says Jens Bentzen, CEO of Dall Energy, in a statement.

"Our unique biomass gasification technology makes it possible to use local biomass - thus contributing to the ultimate goal of 100% renewable and recovered energy," he says.

The agreement with Coriance / Caen la Mer Energie Verte is the largest deal for Dall Energy to date. And it's double the size of the company's previous deal, according to Dall Energy.

"We look forward to continuing the good work in France, and we hope we can use this momentum to expand across Europe soon," says Dall Energy's CEO.
